WAYS TO SERVE WITH FIRST IMPRESSIONS:

Coffee Shop | Greeters/Ushers | Golf Cart Ministry
Medical Response | Welcome Center | Security

How it works...

1. Choose in what role you would like to serve!
2. You will be assigned a team that serves once a month, or more if you wish. If you sign up with a friend or family member, you can serve on the same team. Just let Hannah Kennedy know, and she will coordinate that.
3. The week before you serve, someone will text you and let you know it is your week. If you are out of town or cannot serve, please text them back so we can find a substitute.

EACH ROLE AT A GLANCE...

Second Cup Ministry | This role serves coffee each Sunday morning in the coffee shop. You will learn how to brew carafes of coffee and serve hot chocolate to our church family. You will shadow one of our experienced volunteers to learn the ins and outs of serving the coffee. Coffee shop workers must be 14 years and older.

Ushers and Greeters | Our greeters are the first faces guests see on Sunday morning and are stationed at each exterior doors and worship center doors. This role can be done by anyone at any age who can stand, smile, and greet someone.

Golf Cart Ministry | Our golf cart ministry serves by picking up individuals in the parking lot and dropping them off at the door. You must have a valid drivers license to volunteer in this area.

Medical Response Team | Our medical response team team sits through the service/life group with an ear piece connected to our security team. If a situation arises, they are radioed in to help. You must be a RN, LPN, EMT, or doctor with up to date credentials to volunteer.

Welcome Center Workers | Our Welcome Center workers do a variety of tasks on Sundays in the lobby and children's building. in the lobby, volunteers give out guest bags, greet guests, sell concert tickets, books, and resources.

Security | Our security team plays a vital role on Sundays and during events. They keep a radio headset in and communicate with our security leads to make sure our church family remains safe. These volunteers must be active law enforcement.

WHAT IS THE FIRST IMPRESSIONS MINISTRY?

The First Impressions Ministry is the hospitality ministry of our church. First impressions are not just about making the church "look good". It is about communicating personal value to the people who come in our doors. We value people because God values them. This ministry is responsible for making people feel welcomed, loved, and seen as they attend our church services and ministry activities.
